

# WorkDays—Bringing Catholic Charity to Life

At the heart of the Saint Nicholas Beneficial Society (SNBS) is a desire to serve our fellow man in the name of genuine Christian charity. Inspired by the example of our patron, St. Nicholas of Myra, and guided by the command of Our Lord to love our neighbors, we are pleased to introduce "WorkDays"—a new apostolate for members to volunteer their time and talent for those who need a helping hand.

# Why WorkDays?

Many in our community find themselves without the means or ability to maintain their homes and properties, whether due to age, infirmity, lack of income, or simply

overwhelming circumstances. WorkDays brings together volunteers to assist with critical household tasks such as painting, carpentry, plumbing, yardwork, cleaning, and even farm chores. Our goal is to lift burdens from those who cannot accomplish these tasks on their own, offering both practical help and fraternal support. When needed, the volunteers also pool their resources to purchase paint, cleaning supplies, or the right tools for the project—ensuring the work is completed thoroughly and with care.

### **How It Works**

When someone in need reaches out to SNBS, our coordinators visit the home to assess the scope of the project. We work with the homeowner to schedule a convenient weekend, gather the necessary materials, and recruit volunteers. Over successive Saturdays, a dedicated team of "Friends of Saint Nicholas" will then arrive, tools in hand, ready to serve.

# Still in Need: Help a Young Family Build a Future

We are reaching out again on behalf of a remarkable young family who continues to face serious challenges and needs the support of our community.

This Mexican couple and their two young children have spent the past seven years as part of our traditional Roman Catholic community. Each year, they return under the official U.S. foreign worker program so the father can work on a local organic farm, learning and contributing to sustainable agriculture. Despite their hard work and deep commitment, they face significant barriers to stability.

# **An Urgent Need for Transportation**

One of the most significant challenges this family faces is transportation. Without a reliable vehicle, they struggle to access essential services such as healthcare, grocery shopping, and attending church. A safe, working-condition automobile would grant this family the independence they need to thrive. We are reaching out to our generous community members who might have a vehicle they no longer need. Donating a car, or even selling it at a low price, would be a profound act of kindness that could transform their daily lives.

# **A Path Toward Stability**

Due to U.S. regulations for seasonal workers, this family must return to Mexico each year before reentering the U.S.—a difficult journey, especially with two young children. Despite these challenges, they've built a modest home in Pennsylvania and remain hopeful for a more permanent life here.

Their next step is applying for a Green Card, allowing them to stay year-round and begin the path to citizenship. But the immigration process is long and complex, and they need legal guidance from someone well-versed in U.S. foreign worker regulations. Legal immigrants and seasonal workers face numerous challenges in securing permanent work status, including lengthy wait times and extensive paperwork.
